

Installation Procedure

1. Download and unzip the installation file to a directory (in our example c:\mossdeploy) One of the files that should have been extracted is DataSprings_RandomImage.wsp
2. Execute the following cmd using STSADM.EXE (typically under c:\program files\common files\Microsoft Shared\web server extensions\12\bin\), or, use the shortcut that is provided and also extracted called quickdir.bat

STSADM -o addsolution -filename "c:\mossdeploy\DataSprings_RandomImage.wsp"

3. Navigate to your central administration page
 - a. Click on Operations
 - b. Click on Solution Management (last link under the section Global Configuration)



- c. Click on DataSprings_RandomImage.wsp
- d. Click on deploy (select now or a date and time along with what site(s) you would like to deploy the web part to)



Your web part should now be available to be added to your Sharepoint portal.

After installation notes:

Important: Do not add the RandomImage.dll to the GAC. The web part renders files located in the wpresources directory and this directory is different if the DLL is added to the GAC.

Troubleshooting:

If you run into any issues, please add to the querystring that the web part is on &Debug=True. Please provide this information to our support staff.

Web part not displaying: You might need to modify the web.config file.

Replace the line:

Trust = "WSS_Minimal"

With

Trust = "WSS_Medium"

Setting up Random Image Web Part:

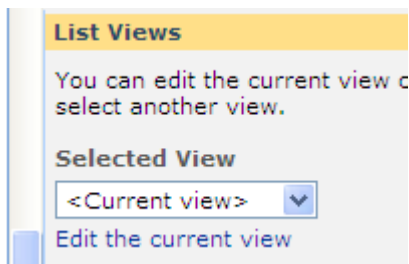
The random image web part works as a connecting tool between two web parts. To setup your list of random images follow the following steps:

Step 1: Add the web parts to the page

- Add a standard image web part to the page, a Random Image web part to the page, and a list of images (document library) to the page.
- Navigate within the Random Image Web Part and the document library web part to 'Modify Shared Web Part', Layout and check the 'Hidden' checkbox.



- Make sure you have an 'ID' column visible within your document library of images. To enable the ID Column navigate to 'Modify Shared Web Part' within the document library web part, and click on 'Edit Current View'. Check the checkbox next to the 'ID' column to enable it.

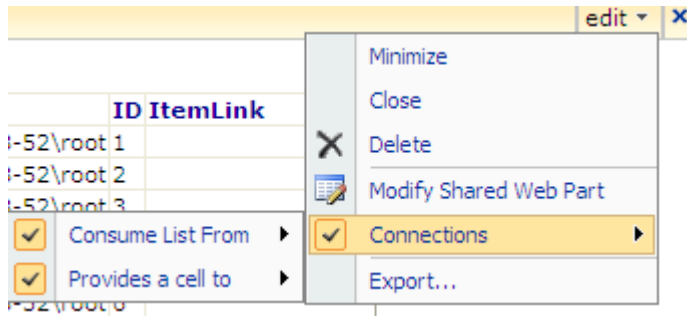

Step 2: Connect the web parts

The Random Image Web Part works by connecting a list (your document library) and a standard image web part (where the random image will be displayed). Within the Random Image Web Part you can setup your connection to the two web parts.

Navigate within the web part menu to connections:



Specify the document library list of images web part for the 'Consume List From', and the standard image web part for the 'Provides a cell to'.

Note: If you do not see any web parts listed to connect to you probably have not added the appropriate web parts to the page. You must add a document library of images and a standard image web part.
